

CBHS 3rd Trimester Summer School 2017: 5-24-17

for students who earn a 2+ in the 3rd trimester in math, science, English or social studies (OR otherwise by teacher permission)

To be on track for graduation, students need to earn at least ten credits a year. Eight credits in English are required for graduation – as well as six in math, science and social studies. We strongly encourage students to do whatever it takes to stay on the path towards graduation. Portland Public Schools will again be offering summer school courses in English, math, social studies and science. Students may sign up for ONE course (and possibly two) through PPS Summer School, this year hosted by Deering High School. The class will run weekdays from July 5-26th, 8am to 12:10. CBHS will also be offering a Math Workshop and 2 science intensives for credit this summer. Official registration forms and costs for these summer options can be found on the CBHS website (in the “Academics” section) or outside Mr. Pierce’s office.

In our effort to support all students meeting rigorous, vital standards, Casco Bay High School will also be offering our own standards-based school.
