

ADVANCED ART 2014-2015

Advanced art is a studio course in which students will increase technical skills, develop a more sophisticated approach to process and subject matter, and create a portfolio of individual work. In this class students will keep an artist journal to explore artistic process, experiment with materials and analyze work. Through experimentation and refinement, each person will create a body of work that includes observational drawing, mixed media and a variety of self-chosen media. The studio environment of the class will be used to support analysis, reflection and refinement of work. In Advanced Art, emphasis will be placed on contemporary art. Visits to local galleries and museums will provide inspiration and exposure to the current Portland art scene.

This class is appropriate for students who wish to put together a portfolio for college application.

Content Standards:

Creation, Performance and Expression:

- Students use multiple media, tools and process to create a variety of original work.*
- Students create a body of original work that demonstrates a sophisticated use of media, tools, process and techniques.*
- Students communicate a variety of ideas, feelings and meanings*

Creative Problem Solving:

- Students apply and analyze creative problem skills to improve or vary their work.*

Aesthetic and Criticism:

- Describe, analyze, interpret and evaluate art forms by applying arts concepts, vocabulary, skills and process.*

Composition Skills:

- Students use Elements of Art and Principles of Design to create original art works that demonstrate development of personal style in a variety of media and visual art forms.*

Stewardship:

- Students demonstrate appropriate use of materials, tools and space.*
